

CV of prof. Tamaz Joseph Shioshvili

Was born 06.29.1941 in Batumi (Georgia). Ended the middle school with a gold medal (1958) and medical institute in Tbilisi (1965). Worked as urologist in Tselinograd (Astana, Kazakhstan) city hospital. Post-graduate student in urology in Tsulukidze Scientific-Research Institute of Urology and Nephrology in Tbilisi (1968-1971). Senior research worker (1972-1985), head of urological department for adults in the same Institute (1985-1989). Chief of Chair of Urology in Tbilisi State Medical Academy (1989-2012). General director of urological and emergency clinic for perfection of doctors LTD (2012 up today).

Defended the thesis for the bachelor of science "Use of the local hypothermia during the operations on a "dry" kidney (1972, Tbilisi) and thesis for the doctor of medical sciences: Influence of non specific factors (denervation, ischemia) on the kidney transplant and ways for reduction of their negative action (Moscow, 1982).

Fields of interests: use the microsurgical techniques in urology, elaboration of original reconstructive surgical methods and equipment in urology, elaboration of minimally invasive methods of BPH treatment.

First in the world performed the successful replantation of the testis after its autohemicastration.

First in the USSR and GDR performed the autotransplantation of testes in case of abdominal cryptorchidismus.

Rewarded with a gold medal in the international Fair in Leipzig, Germany (1982) for the exhibit "The apparatus for the local renal hypothermia".

Active member of European Urological Association, Georgian Ecologic and New-York Academies of Sciences.

Author of 140 works, 35 inventions, 4 monographs.
